In **HISTORY/THEOLOGY** we'll dig deep in the Bible to understand Christian doctrine and how God has preserved His church for two thousand years.

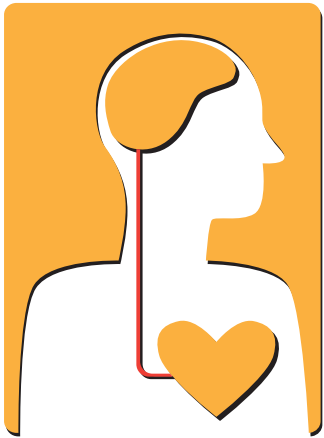

Becoming a Well-Dressed Woman (Jan 4 - Feb 29)

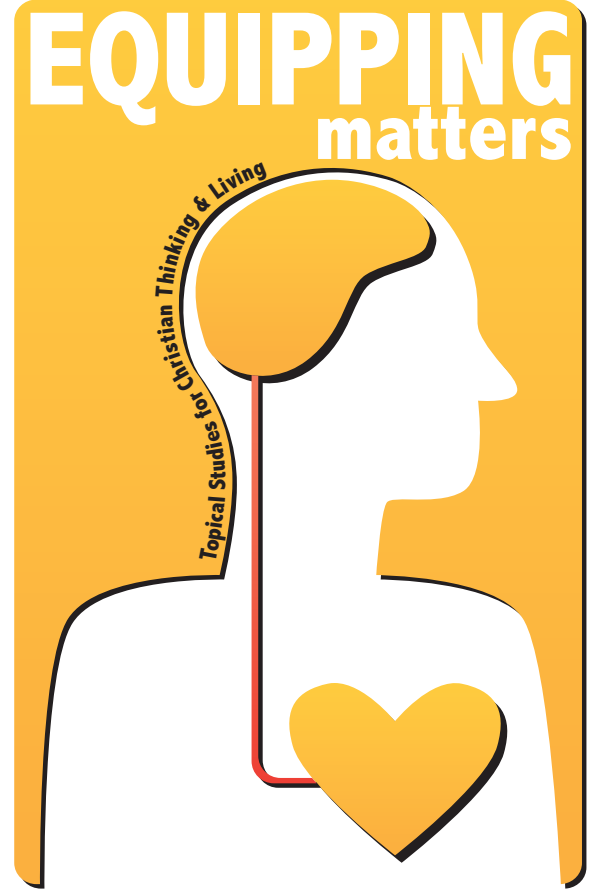
This class will take a look at the armor of God in Ephesians 6 and how we can allow God to equip us for the everyday battles we face at home, work, with our friends, and even at church.
